

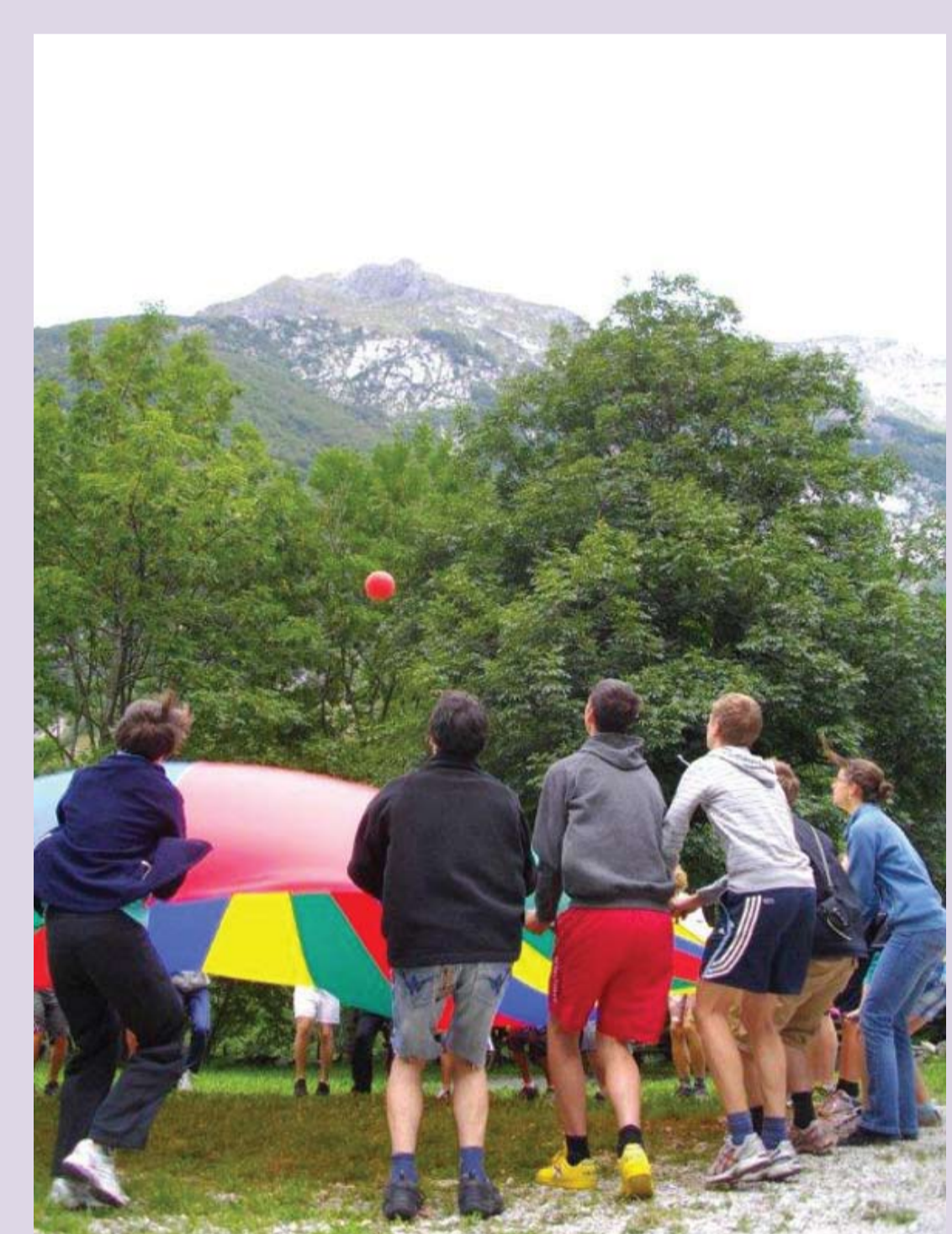
Dejavnost mladih

Mountaineering for children and youth



Mladinska komisija,

ustanovljena leta 1956, je eden najmočnejših členov PZS. Skrbi za najmlajšo populacijo ljubiteljev planin. Svoje aktivnosti ima razporejene na področjih orientacije, izobraževanja za mlade, dela z mladimi, družabnosti, založništva, ..., sodeluje pa tudi v različnih projektih in s sorodnimi prostovoljnimi organizacijami doma in v tujini. Je stalna članica Youth Commission UIAA. Najmlajše in mlade v vrtcih, šolah in planinskih društvih vzgajajo mentorji planinskih skupin v okviru prenovljenih programov Ciciban in Mladi planinec. Komisija izvaja seminarje za mentorje planinskih skupin, seminarje družabnosti v gorah, tečaje za mladinske voditelje, izobraževanje za traserje in vaditelje orientacije, posvete za vodje planinskih taborov, Državno tekmovanje Mladina in gore, tekmovanja Ekspont, planinska orientacijska tekmovanja in druga srečanja. V skrbništvu ima Planinsko učno središče Bavšica. Obmejna planinska društva vsako leto organizirajo Srečanje mladih treh dežel Alpe Adria Alpin.



The Youth Commission,

founded in 1956, is one of the strongest links of the Alpine Association of Slovenia (Planinska zveza Slovenije). It works with and for the young mountain lovers. The activities of the Youth Commission are focused on navigation, youth training, work with young climbers and mountaineers, social activities, and publishing. Besides, the Commission participates in various projects and cooperates closely with other comparable voluntary organizations in Slovenia and abroad. It is a permanent member of the UIAA Youth Commission. Young mountaineers learn the basics of climbing in kindergartens, schools and mountaineering groups through renewed age-adjusted programmes for mountain climbing, Ciciban planinec (Preschool Mountaineer) and Mladi planinec (Young Mountaineer). The Youth Commission organizes seminars for mountaineering group mentors and workshops on socializing in the mountains. Furthermore, the Commission holds courses for youth leaders, training sessions for trail makers and navigation instructors, and conferences for leaders of alpine camps and the coordinators of the national competitions Mladina in gore (The Youth and the Mountains), Ekspont (Exponent), and other navigation competitions and other gatherings. The Youth Commission manages the Mountaineering Education Centre Bavšica. Every year the alpine clubs located near the national borders organize Alpe Adria Alpin, a gathering of young mountaineers from Italy, Austria, and Slovenia.
